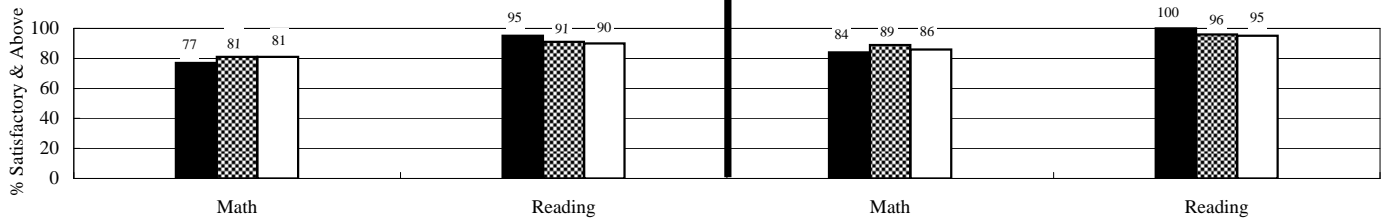

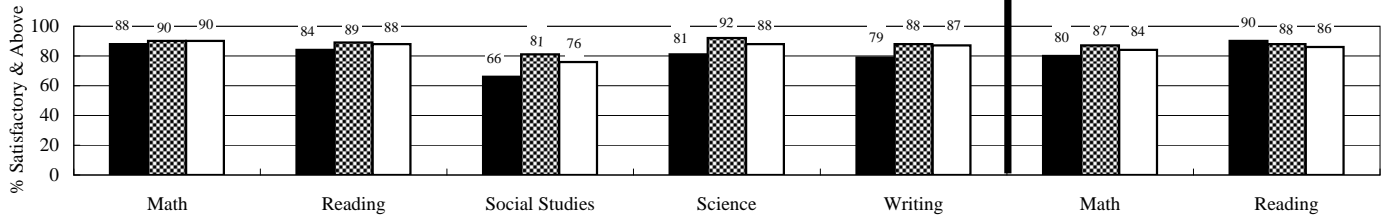
### 3rd Grade Tests \*

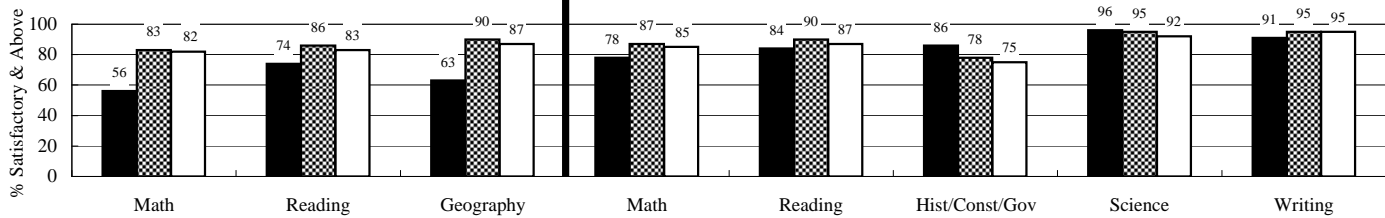

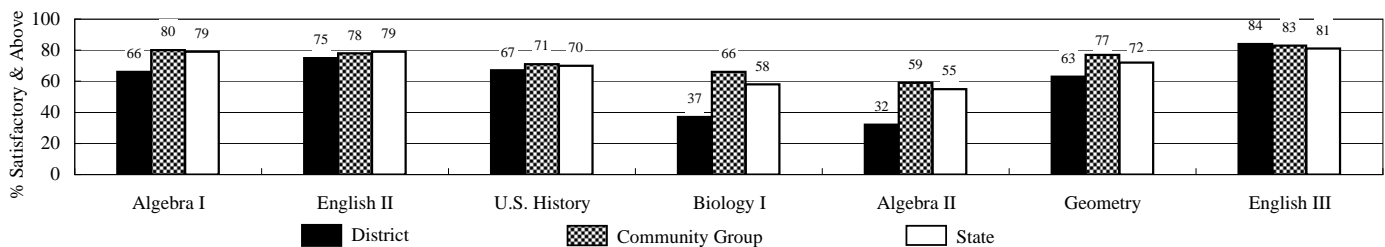
