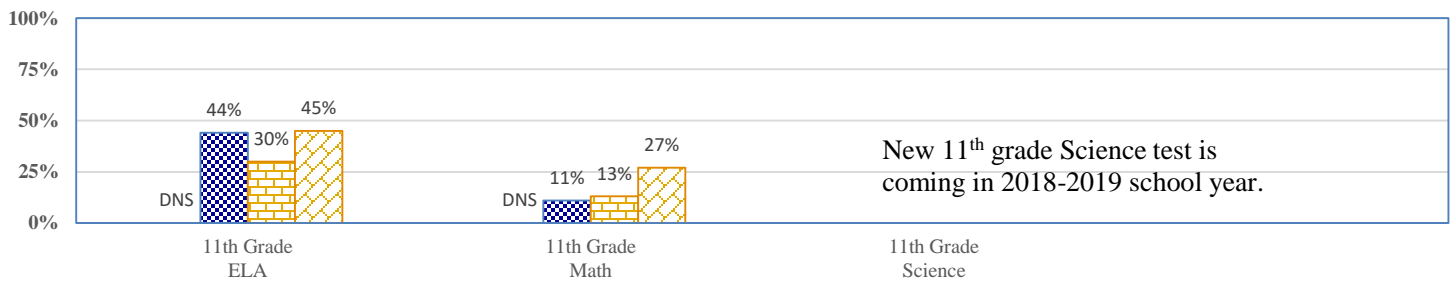

New 11th grade Science test is coming in 2018-2019 school year.

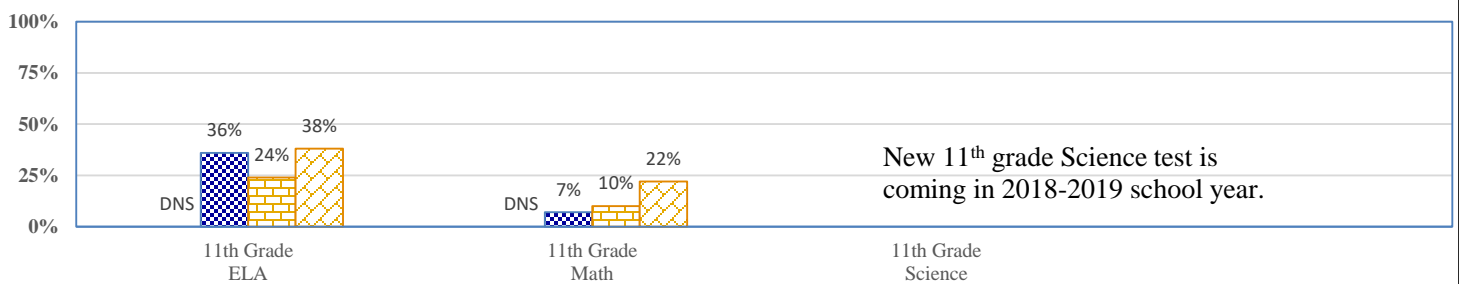
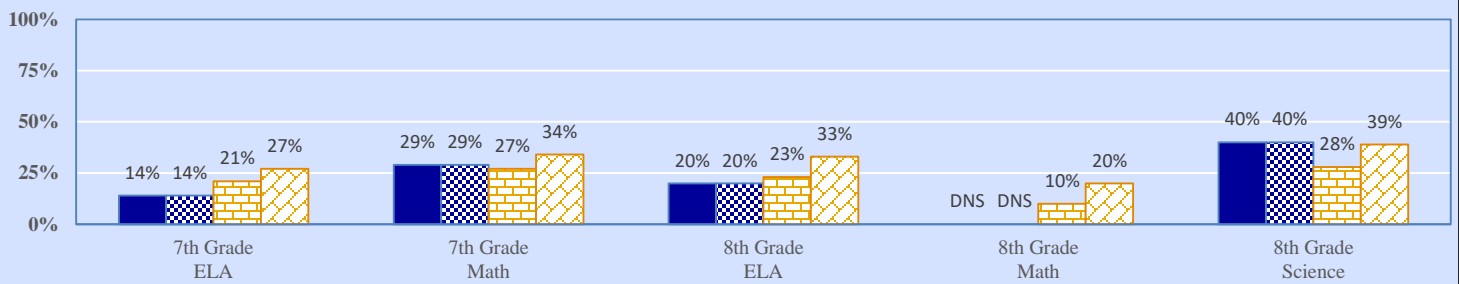
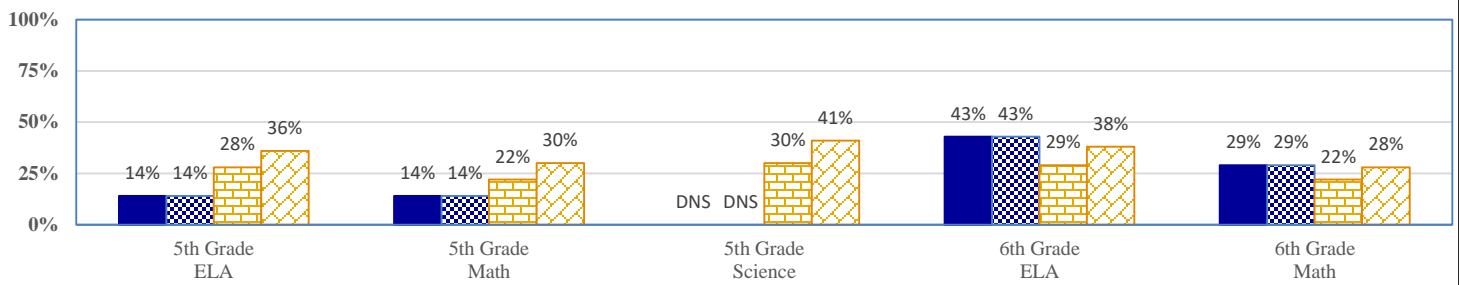
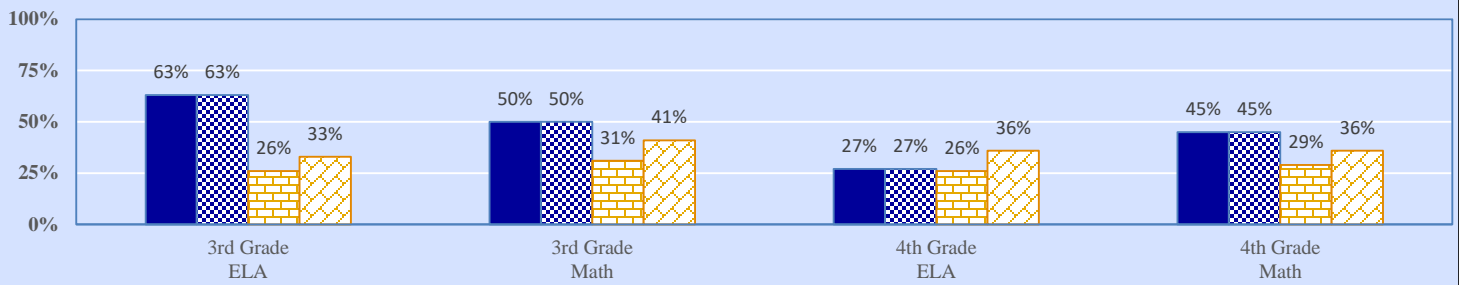
